

The Consumer Price Index in Taipei for November 2010

The Consumer Price Index(CPI) in Taipei for November 2010 was 105.86(2006=100), rising 0.04% from previous month. Mainly because prices of Personal Care Services and Fuels & Lubricants moved up 5.50% and 2.10% respectively. Besides, prices of Household Appliances moved up 1.05%, due to higher cotton price on international market.

The annual change for CPI in Taipei for November 2010, compared with the same month of previous year, moved up 1.48%. Prices of Food rose 2.87%, of which prices of Vegetables and Food Away from Home moved up 23.04% and 1.98% respectively. Education & Entertainment fees moved up 1.09%, because Tour fees for traveling overseas increased.

For the first eleven months of 2010, the CPI increased by 0.42% over the same period of previous year. Prices of Transportation & Communication moved up 2.75%, prices of Housing went up 0.39%, prices of Food went up 0.32%, prices of Clothing moved up 2.05%, prices of Medicines and Medical Care went up 1.11%, prices of Miscellaneous went up 0.94%, Education & Entertainment fees moved down 1.57%.
